

Photographing of Candidates on the 11+ Test Day at CSSE Test Centres

There has been increasing concern expressed by parents about the rigour of identity check procedures in relation to 11+ candidates. As a response to this, and to protect everyone from potential fraud or concern about potential fraud, CSSE test centres will be photographing each candidate (with their name label on them) at the time of registration for the 11+. The photographs will be kept until the end of the Autumn term in which the candidates would be in Year 7 and then destroyed.

If you wish to refuse permission for your child to be photographed you must email the CSSE office by the 14/09/16 at the latest. An alternative means of identification will be sought prior to the day of the test by the CSSE Secretary.
