Bus Transport to Consortium Member Schools – termly tickets only

The CSSE is authorised by Stephenson's and First Essex Buses to sell termly tickets on their school bus routes as well as termly tickets on First Bus Essex public service routes. We are unable to assist with daily, monthly or annual ticket requests or provide route information for public services. **We are unable to offer a ticketing service for any other bus company.** For other bus companies you will need to make a direct arrangement.

Please complete the CSSE transport registration form on our website www.csse.org.uk/transport as soon as possible if you are interested in purchasing termly tickets for your child on bus services operated by Stephenson's or First Bus. Bus routes and prices are also available to view on the CSSE website.

Before you purchase a bus pass from the CSSE you may find it useful to check the Traveline Public Transport website: www.traveline.info for bus stop and route queries. The traveline website is a public transport information service that will give you information on all modes of transport.

We would advise you to register as soon as possible as some routes have limited availability. We will acknowledge receipt of your CSSE registration form, but availability will only be confirmed on receipt of your Autumn Term invoice, which will be emailed to you during the week commencing 18th May 2026.

Important – If on receipt of your invoice you **no longer wish to take up the offer of transport** then please email us immediately so we can update our records. We are unable to take verbal instruction from parents.
